- 11. Placenta Life aims to prepare the placenta within 3 days after the birth. However we will not be held accountable should circumstance arise where the placenta encapsulation cannot be completed until an agreed date and time.
- The Client agrees to store her placenta in the Transport Kit provided and agrees to ensure her placenta remains chilled until collection.
- The Client agrees to contact Placenta Life within 12 hours after birth to arrange safe collection of her placenta and/or home visit.
- 14. The Client consents to the removal of the placenta from the hospital(or home) by the Specialist to the extent necessary for the performance by the Specialist of the placenta services.
